

6. SELECTION OF ENTRIES FOR EXHIBITION AND FINAL JUDGING

Exhibition selection and judging for categories Open, Secondary School Aged and Primary School Aged will take place week commencing 28 September.

Judging for People's Choice (all entries exhibited will be considered) will take place during the exhibition 17 October to 8 November 2009.

The judges decision in all respects will be final and no correspondence will be entered into.

7. WINNING ENTRIES AND DISPLAY OF ENTRIES

Winners will be published in the Mosman Daily and notified by mail or email.

Entries selected for exhibition will be placed on display according to the discretion of Mosman Art Gallery.

8. NON SELECTED PHOTOGRAPHS

Unsuccessful entrants will be notified by post.

Photographs must be collected from Mosman Art Gallery between Monday 5 Oct – Sunday 11 Oct 10am – 5pm. No entries will be returned by mail.

9. COLLECTION OF EXHIBITED ENTRIES

Entries will be available for collection from 2.00pm – 6.00pm Sunday 15 November. All entries not collected by 30 November will be disposed of.

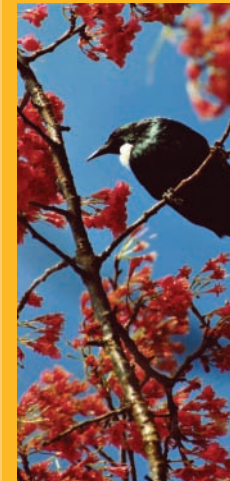
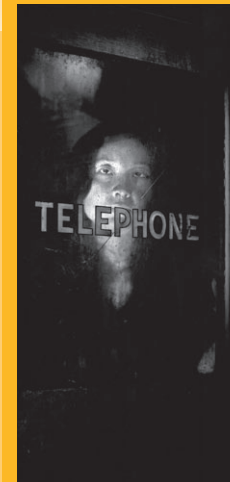

The Photography Competition is a signature event of the 2009 Mosman Festival. Photographs will be selected from competition entries to be exhibited at the Mosman Art Gallery during the Festival. The exhibition opens on Saturday 17 October and closes Sunday 8 November. The theme is open and photographs may be of any subject. A separate prize will be awarded to a photograph with a Mosman subject. The competition is now in its third year and aims to attract entries from photographers of all ages including professionals, amateurs and students.

The competition will be judged by Tamara Voninski, Photo Editor for Fairfax Magazines and founding member of Oculi photographic collection.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. ELIGIBILITY

The competition is open to all permanent Australian residents, with the exception of Mosman Council staff and their immediate family. Entries are submitted on the understanding that the judge reserves the right to select works for display in the exhibition.

2. PRESENTATION

Prints sized A3 or A4 only will be accepted.

Only one copy of each entry is required.

- The competitor may enter up to 2 photos only.
- Entries must not be framed.
- Entries can be produced digitally or traditionally in colour or black and white.
- All work must be printed on photographic paper.

3. ENTRY FEE AND CLOSING DATE

There is no entry fee.

Entries close 5.00pm Friday 25 September. Entries with a post mark date received after Friday 25 September 2009 will not be eligible for selection.

4. IDENTIFICATION

The entry must be clearly marked on the back with the title of the photograph, photographer's name, address, phone number and email address (if applicable) and should be consistent with the entry form. The entry form must be submitted with the entry.
